Centrally located in the heart of the country and found just outside Birmingham city centre, Woodbrooke is easily accessible by motorway, via the A38, as well as having convenient public transport links by train and bus.

A Perfect Location

Woodbrooke is situated on a 10-acre site of organically managed gardens, grounds and woodland with its own lake and stream.

Located on the A38 south Birmingham, around 5 miles from the City Centre, Woodbrooke benefits from being a short distance from the city as well as being in walking distance of key points, including The University of Birmingham; The Royal Orthopaedic Hospital and Cadbury World.

With an abundance of restaurants, cafes and bars located within close proximity in Selly Oak, Harborne and Kings Heath, as well as several notable landmarks in Bournville, there's a range of leisure options for your delegates just on Woodbrooke's doorstep.

BY RAIL

Local trains from New Street Station to Selly Oak Station take about 10 minutes. From Selly Oak Station it is a short bus ride down to Woodbrooke or a 20-25 minute walk.

BY BUS


If you are travelling by bus, please find the most up to date bus routes and ticket prices online via the Travel West Midlands website.


BY ROAD

From the M6 – take Junction 6 and head towards the M38 Aston Expressway which will turn into the A38 Bristol Road. Continue for around five miles.

From the M40 – join the M42, exiting the M42 at Junction 2. Take the A441 towards Birmingham (signposted Cadbury World). After six miles, turn left onto the A38 Bristol Road. Woodbrooke is on the left after Fircroft College.

From the M5 Junction 4 – take the A38 (travelling north) for approximately six miles.
